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## Foster Program Supplement to the Volunteer Application

Our Volunteer Foster Care Program is the foundation to saving lives at Mutts & Mayhem Animal Rescue. Without our Volunteer Foster Parents and Families, we simply could not save lives. At the present time, we are a Foster based Rescue Organization and do not have a traditional brick and mortar shelter facility. Foster homes provide our Rescue Animals with a safe, domesticated environment to live their lives until they are adopted. Foster homes are very special in the sense that they better prepare Rescue Animals for their adoptive home and families. In Foster homes the Rescue Animals will be less stressed, they will be able to show their true personalities and also have the opportunity to receive positive discipline and training. Foster homes not only allow for us to provide some relief to our local overcrowded shelters, but often we care for Animals with conditions that are not manageable in a traditional shelter setting, whether it be medical, physiological due to extreme neglect or abuse and/or behavioral issues.

Although previous fostering experience is not required, the ideal Foster Care Provider will have basic knowledge of animal care and training and be equally committed to finding their Foster Care Animal(s) a safe and loving "forever home". As a Foster Care Provider, you will provide the animals with all of their daily care including, compassion, patience, safety, food, water, shelter, training, grooming and medical treatment when necessary. All medical costs for Rescue Animals are paid for by MMAR. Fostering a Rescue Animal is a wonderful and rewarding experience but can also be time consuming and hard work. Please seriously consider all of the aspects of the Foster Care Program before deciding to apply to become a Foster Parent or Family.
